



### APPLICATION FOR LEASE RECORDING

This is an application to record a cat's lease to an FCPI breeder. A cat being leased must have an FCPI registration number at the time of lease recording application. The **LESSOR** is the breeder/owner who authorizes the use of their cat for breeding for a fee or otherwise. The **LESSEE** is the breeder who intends to register the litter arising from the successful mating of the leased cat and their own cat. Lessors and lessees must be FCPI members in good standing.

An approved lease is valid up to one year or shorter depending on the validity date applied for by the cat's owner. Litters born 65 days after the lease date expiration may not be registered with the FCPI unless a lease extension had been approved.
